This report is written by Police Officer Kristyn Kukowski, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/05/97 at 1:58AM Officers were dispatched to a reckless use of a weapon at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. Investigation revealed that there was a physical confrontation between two Males, and three Females. Tavern security escorted the parties outside the bar. Once outside the bar one of the Males went to an auto returning to the parking lot where he drew a revolver from his waistband, and fired several shots. No one was injured, and the suspect fled the scene in an auto. Employees of the bar stated that the Males were causing trouble from the minute that they arrived in the bar. The bartenders said that no one could serve them fast enough. The licensee was not on the scene. Criminal complaint filed.
2. On Saturday, 03/29/98 at about 2:18AM Officers responded to a reckless use of a weapon complaint at Junior's Bar located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. Upon their arrival Officers learned that several security personnel attempted to escort a man out of the tavern. When he refused, they physically removed him out into the parking lot. After arguing with security the individual apparently walked to his car. About one minute later, witnesses heard one gunshot. The bullet went through the South window of the tavern into the bar, and out the North wall. There were 10 to 15 persons inside the tavern at that time. A check of the area where the shot came from revealed four 9mm casings. A suspect was arrested, and charged with recklessly endangering safety.

3. On 06/14/98 a group of men were involved in an altercation in the parking lot of Junior's Sports Bar located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. This led to a brief vehicle chase to the area of 20th & Silver Spring Dr. The auto which was being chased stopped in front of 5437 N. 20th St. where he was boxed in by two vehicles. The driver of one of the pursuing vehicles began shooting at the victims auto firing 2 to 5 shots. One of the bullets struck the victim in the right tricep. Criminal Complaint filed.
4. On Monday, 10/19/98 at about 12:13AM Officers were dispatched to Junior's bar located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. for underage drinkers. Officers were unable to locate any underage persons inside the tavern. The Class B Tavern license was not posted, and the licensee was not on the scene. The applicant received a warning.
5. On 01/17/99 at 1:12AM Officers were dispatched to check for a subject wanted at Junior's Sports Bar & Grill located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. Upon their arrival the manager of the bar informed Officers that there was a subject in the bar who was involved in a Recklessly endangering safety about a year ago. While interviewing the suspect (Earnest Walker) he became loud and profane. The suspects Brother (Kevin Walker) also became disorderly. Both subjects were issued citations for Disorderly Conduct. The Recklessly Endangering Safety complaint had been cleared earlier. The licensee was not on the scene.
6. On 01/17/99 at about 11:38PM Officers were dispatched to investigate a fight at Juniors bar & Grill located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. Upon the Officers arrival Tavern security stated that the subjects involved had already left.
7. On 07/05/99 a subject inside Junior's Sports Bar & Grill located at 5409 N. Green Bay Av. was attempting to fight with another patron. This subject was restrained by security personnel, and continued to attempt to fight with the patron. Once outside of the tavern this subject attempted to get past Officers to get inside of the tavern. He was placed under arrest, and charged with Disorderly Conduct.
8. On 03/08/00 Devon L. Reid filed a Renewal Alcohol Beverage License Application for the renewal of his Class B Tavern license. On this application he answered No to question #5a which asks in part if since filing of the last application if he has been convicted of any municipal ordinance violations. On 07/08/99 Mr. Reid was convicted of a Building & Zone Violation, and he paid a fine of \$920.00.

Charge : Truth of Statements & Affidavits – Falsifying

9. On 05/07/2001, at 12:38AM, officers were dispatched to 5409 N Green Bay Avenue regarding a report of shots fired. On arrival, they spoke to the manager of the bar, who stated an unknown male in his early 20s (description given) began a fight with other unknown patron, culminating with an undetermined number of shots being fired by an unknown subject shortly after the above listed male patron left the establishment. A search of the area outside the establishment turned up three casings. No one interviewed following the incident was able to identify the shooter, nor observed the shooter as he fired the rounds. No one was injured as a result of this incident

10. On 07/16/2005 at 2:30 AM officers were in the immediate area of Questions, 3401 W North Av regarding cruising and a large crowd. One vehicle involved in the cruising was stopped and the driver was cited for Disorderly Conduct. (It was not determined if this actor came from Questions.) Incident Report Filed.
  11. On 10/09/2005 at 12:18 AM officers were in the area of Questions, 3401 W North Av regarding cruising and large crowds. Officers report "It took several hours to control the cruising in the area of Questions Tavern." There were approximately 100 vehicles blocking traffic. A total of 7 squads from three police districts (3, 4, and 6) were required to control the crowd. Incident Report Filed.
  12. On 11/19/2005 at 12:40 AM officers responded to the licensed premises at 3401 W North Av, Questions, because of a disturbance within large crowd (75-100 patrons) waiting to enter the bar. As officers were monitoring the crowd they heard the sound of a single gun shot coming from the direction of the disturbance. No weapons or suspects were found and the crowd was dispersed. Incident Report Filed.

13. On 03-04-06 at 2:00 am, Milwaukee Police conducted a capacity check on Questions at 3041 W North Avenue. Officers entered the tavern and found people from wall to wall. As patrons were leaving, officers used a hand counter to count them. The capacity for the tavern was 340. At about 400, officers informed the licensee, Devon Reid, that he was over capacity. The final count was 597 patrons, which did not include any of the security or tavern staff. A citation for over capacity was issued to Reid. No other violations were observed.

14. On 05-06-06 at 1:40 am, Milwaukee Police observed a large crowd at Questions Tavern and began counting patrons as they were leaving the bar. Officers knew the capacity was 320 people and had found the tavern had 516 patrons in the tavern. This did not count the 20+ staff that was working inside the tavern. The owner, Devon Reid, was cited for patrons over capacity.

15. On 06-03-06 at 1:15 am, officers observed 50 citizens running out the back door of Questions Night Club, 3041 W North Avenue. Officers were approached by several persons who stated there was a fight inside the tavern. Officers looked inside the tavern and observed approximately 200 people fighting. Back up was called and 13 squads from 3 different districts responded to break up the fight. Several patrons received citations for disorderly conduct and the licensee, Devon Reid, was cited for disorderly premises.

16. On 09-01-06 at 1:00 am, officers observed approximately 175 vehicles parked in the area of Questions. Officers canvassed the area to see if there were any businesses opens or house parties going on and found nothing. Officers had received an anonymous tip from a subject that Questions may be over capacity. Officers notified the licensee, Devon Reid, that they would be counting patrons as they left the tavern. Capacity is 340 and the final count of patrons that had been in the tavern was 404. Security also stated that there was a fight earlier, but that they, ( security) had broken it up. Two more fights broke out outside the tavern has the crowd was dispersing from the tavern, resulting in officers breaking up the fight. Two citations were issued to Reid for Posting of Occupancy Capacity and Disorderly Premise.

17. On 09-08-06 at 12:03 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue for shots fired. Investigation revealed that security at Questions Night Club stated they refused entry to a male subject who became angry. Security stated as the subject walked away, they heard shots fired in the area, but did not see who was shooting. Officers did observe a male subject who had entered a vehicle nearby throw something in the bushes. A handgun was later recovered and a casing found nearby. Officers were unable to find any witnesses regarding this incident. The gun and casing were placed on inventory and a report was filed.

18. On 10-20-06 at 1:40 am, Milwaukee Police were sent to 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue for a Subject with Gun complaint. Investigation revealed that security for Questions Night Club was trying to disperse the crowd that was leaving from the tavern, when one male patron threatened one of the security guards saying he had a gun and made threats to shoot the security guard. This male patron was later arrested after a brief car chase and no gun was found. A routine wanted check revealed that the subject was a convicted felon. The arrestee was charged with Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing an Officer.

19. On 11-03-06 at 1:26 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a fight. Officers spoke with security guards who work for Questions Night Club who stated the several women were involved in multiple "cat fights". Security broke it up and removed the women from the club. The dispatcher advised officers that there were numerous calls of shots fired with a security guard at the scene as a witness. Officers spoke to the guard, who works for Questions Night Club, who stated he observed a B/M in a white four door Chevy Suburban with tinted windows, fire shots up into the air as the vehicle sped off. Officers did find casings at 3140 W North Avenue, the WE Energies parking lot and placed them on inventory. Security was unable to provide descriptions of the shooter.

20. On 11-25-06 at 1:52 am, officers observed Statagic Agency security personnel, which is employed by Questions Tavern, attempting to pull an individual from an auto. Investigation revealed that a fight had taken place in Questions with one patron being hit in the head with a gun (allegedly be a security guard) and another patron, who had fled the scene with security chasing said patron. Officers were told by security that they had chased the patron because they believed he was armed with a gun. Statagic security advised the officers that the gun was under the seat on the passengers' side of the car. Officers found a gun under the seat and the subject was taken into custody. This subject was charged with Felon in Possession of Firearm. The other patron was treated for his head injury and an investigation is still pending regarding a substantial battery charge. The licensee, Devon Reid was cited for Disorderly Premises.

21. On 12-08-06, Milwaukee Police conducted a tavern check at Questions Night Club, 3041 W North Avenue. Officers observed several patrons that looked to be younger than 21 years of age. Two patrons were under the age of 21 and one stated he gained entry by giving the doorman an extra \$10.00 to let him in. During the investigation, a fight broke out and officers observed several patrons fighting each other and security. While officers were writing citations for the disturbance, another fight broke out with bottles being thrown. These patrons were separated by security and police and escorted out of the tavern. One individual refused to cooperate and continued to engage the other patrons to fight. This subject was arrested. A small bag of marijuana was found on the floor of the tavern and placed on inventory. Several citations for Disorderly Conduct, Presence of Underage and Resisting/Obstructing were issued. The licensee, Devon Reid, received citations for Presence of Underage and Disorderly Premises.

22. On 12-14-06, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Questions to meet security officers who were detaining a subject who was possibly armed with a gun. Investigation revealed security was not allowing any more patrons into the bar due to reaching the bar's capacity. A patron, who was not allowed in the tavern, began yelling obscenities and refused to cooperate with security. At one point, this patron threatened he was leaving to go get his gun. Security attempted to detain this patron, who began to run, but was eventually caught and decentralized to the ground. This subject sustained minor injuries when decentralized by security. Officers spoke to a witness, the subject's friend, who stated his friend did make a threat to get his gun and that he shouldn't have. This subject was cited for Disorderly Conduct and the security guard, who decentralized the subject to the ground, was charged with Battery.

23. On 12-31-06 at 11:09 pm, Milwaukee Police were flagged down by security at Questions for Trouble with Subjects. Investigation revealed two patrons were asked to leave a private party that was going on at the tavern that night. These patrons began to make threats to harm security personnel. The patrons were arrested and issued Disorderly Conduct citations.

24. On 12-31-06 at 11:33 pm, Milwaukee Police responded to Questions for a Subject with Gun complaint. Investigation revealed no one was armed with any guns and the caller was uncooperative with police. The staff at Questions was advised of the nature of the call.

25. On 01-01-07 at 12:37 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a fight at the Questions Nightclub. Police arrested three subjects and issued citations for Disorderly Conduct. While there, officers reported shots fired, just west of their location, with a stray bullet hitting a vehicle near the scene. A report was filed for that incident.

26. On 01-01-07 at 1:52 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched again to Questions for another reported fight in the tavern. As officers arrived, they called for more back up due to a large fight at that location. At least 14 squads responded and a total of 8 people were arrested and cited for Disorderly Conduct and/or Resisting/Obstructing. Two police officers were injured during this incident. Captain James Harpole was on scene and ordered Questions to be shut down and officers were needed to get patrons to leave the premises.

Item's 16, 20, 21 were previously reported, dispositions now added.

27. On 02/02/07 at 1:15 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Fight complaint. Investigation revealed several patrons began to fight with one of them throwing a bottle of beer at a security guard. He was not injured. This same security guard then deployed a two second burst of pepper spray into the crowd to disperse them. The guard then observed a patron pick up a chair and throw it through a glass window inside the tavern. The guard tackled this patron to the ground and detained him for police. This patron was issued a citation for Vandalism and one for Disorderly Conduct. The owner, Devon Reid, was on scene and stated that an unknown person was thought to have been selling drugs inside the tavern and when this person was asked to leave, a fight broke out.

28. On 05/11/07 at 1:24 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue for a shooting complaint. Investigation revealed an argument started between two patrons who used to date one another. The argument moved outside of Questions and resulted in a shooting with two people getting shot. Casings were recovered from 3119 W Garfield where the shooter was firing shots. Officers spoke to the licensee, Devon Reid, who supplied detectives' logs of photographs with patrons' personal information as the patrons entered the tavern.

29. On 07/16/07 at 12:30 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Call for Police complaint. Investigation revealed a patron had become disorderly and was instigating fights inside the tavern. Security tried escorting this patron out of the tavern when another patron began pushing on one of the security guards. Both patrons then began to fight with security in attempts to hit them. One security guard sprayed his OC in the faces of these patrons. Police issued two citations to these subjects for Disorderly Conduct.

30. On 09/14/07 at 1:20 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Fight complaint. Investigation revealed a fight started near the doors to the tavern and escalated into the street where it broke up. While police were there, they observed a large crowd inside and has concerns regarding the issue of capacity. It was determined that 392 patrons were inside not counting employees. Capacity is 320. The licensee, Devon Reid, stated he thought capacity was 340. A citation was issued to Reid for Over Capacity.

31. On 09/21/07 at 12:48 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Questions Tavern for traffic and crowd control. Several more squads had to be called to the large crowd in and outside of the tavern. Squads were needed in this area until 2:03 am, when the last squad cleared from the scene.

32. On 09/28/07, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 3041 W North Avenue. Officers observed a large amount of vehicles parked in the area and once inside the tavern, observed a large crowd estimated at over 300. Officers began counting patrons as they left and found 347 patrons were inside. This did not include the 15 employees of the tavern. Capacity is 320. The owner, Devon Reid stated he wasn't sure about the number of people in the club but he thought the capacity was 340. A citation was issued for Posting of Occupancy Capacity.

33. On 10/19/07 at 1:26 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 3041 W North Avenue. As officers arrived, there were many patrons exiting the tavern with some of them yelling at officers that someone was shot and laying in front of Questions Night Club. Officers observed several armed security officers standing near a victim who was found to have been shot several times. The victim was later pronounced dead at the scene. Officers spoke to the security guards who stated they had heard gunshots but were unable to determine who was all involved because of a fight between patrons that they were breaking up. Some descriptions were provided by security in regards to possible suspects along with a vehicle description. Officers attempted to gain entry into Questions Night Club but found that the doors had been locked. It was unknown at the time if the victim or shooting suspects were patrons of Questions Night Club.

Items 30 and 32 were previously reported, disposition now added on 12/12/08.

34. On 01/05/08, security guards for Questions Night Club placed a call to Milwaukee police requesting assistance with subjects who were loitering at the tavern and refusing to leave. Milwaukee police needed three squads to clear the area.

35. On 01/08/08 at 1:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Shots Fired complaint. Officers spoke to security officer Joshua Fritz who stated while patrons were leaving the tavern four shots were fired in the area. Fritz stated he was unsure if the shots were fired at someone and that he did not observe who fired the shots. Fritz further stated to police that there was an altercation with a patron, which resulted in damage to an auto. Investigation revealed that the altercation was in fact an ESBUDW involving Fritz and a known patron. There had been a verbal argument between Fritz and the patron with Fritz pulling his out his gun and pointed it at the victim. Both subjects were in ordered in the DA's office for possible charges. A check a CCAP revealed no charges were issued.
36. On 02/01/08 at 12:44 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for an Arm Robbery complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated she was denied entry into the Questions Club due to an expired ID card. The victim began to walk away from the tavern when she was approached by two males armed with guns demanding her property. The victim stated she ran back to security at the tavern and that is when she heard several gunshots fired. While investigating this Arm Robbery complaint, another subject approached officers stating he was robbed at gunpoint in the same area. Reports were filed in both complaints.
37. On 02/03/08, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Theft complaint. Officers spoke to the caller who stated she had her coat checked at Questions Club and when she attempted to retrieve it, the coat was missing. A report was filed.
38. On 02/08/08 at 12:03 am, Milwaukee police were on patrol when officers observed a verbal argument, which became physical between a patron and security at Questions Night Club. Police spoke to the security guard, Tschombe Davidson, who stated the altercation started because the patron was denied entry due to capacity levels.
39. On 02/08/08 at 2:22 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to St Joseph's Hospital for a Battery complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated he was at Questions Night Club when an unknown actor walked up to him and struck him in the face with an unknown object. The victim suffered a 2 inch laceration to his upper lip. A report was filed.
40. On 02/10/08 9:42 pm, Milwaukee police took a complaint from a victim who stated while he was a patron at Questions and unknown subject took his cell phone from his jacket that was hung on the back of a chair. A report was filed.
41. On 02/15/08 at 11:54 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for traffic congestion. Police cleared autos from the area and issued 12 parking tickets to autos illegally parked that were contributing to the traffic congestion. As officers cleared the area, security for Questions Night Club escorted two groups of individuals out of the bar for fighting. Police spoke to Devon Reid regarding these incidents and traffic problems. On 02/15/08 at 1:31 am, Milwaukee police were called to St Joseph's Hospital for two Substantial Battery complaints. Both victims stated they were at Questions Night Club and involved in fights in which both victims received lacerations that required stitches. Reports were filed.

42. On 02/25/08 at 1:07 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to Questions for a Disturbance complaint. Investigation revealed a security guard and a patron were involved in an altercation with police being called. A total of five squads were needed for traffic and crowd control.
43. On 02/29/08 at 12:53 am, Milwaukee police were flagged down by security for Questions regarding a fight that had started inside the tavern and was now moved out to parking lot. Officers were breaking up the fight and while doing so, several other fights broke out between patrons of the club. Additional squads were needed to assist with breaking up the fights. Ten squads and one supervisor were needed to restore order from the near capacity crowd of 480 from Questions Club. Several citations were issued for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing Officers in addition to 27 citations issued for parking violations.
44. On 03/05/08 at 12:15 am, Milwaukee police observed several cars in the area of 3041 W Questions illegally parked. A total of 19 parking tickets were issued with two cars being towed. One patron whose car was being towed entered her auto and attempted to drive off to prevent her car from being towed. As she attempted to leave in the auto, she struck another car and fled the scene of the accident. She was later stopped by police and arrested for OWI. Further investigation found the patron was underage and had another subjects ID so she could gain entry into Questions. This subject was issued several citations and charged with OWI, PBAC +12 and Hit and Run.
45. On 03/14/08 at 1:00 am, Milwaukee police were monitoring Questions tavern due to complaints of traffic and crowd congestion. Many patrons leaving the tavern were observed to be disorderly by yelling and screaming profanities to passing autos with some patrons starting arguments. Regarding the traffic and crowd congestion, the entire scene was video taped for further reference. A total of six squads were needed for traffic and crowd control.
46. On 03/15/08 at 1:36 am, Milwaukee police responded to Questions for a Fight complaint. Officers were advised that fight started inside the club and spilled out onto the streets. Police observed numerous females that were involved in altercations and when police attempted to break the fights up these same females began fighting police. In addition, vehicles that were leaving the tavern blocked the intersections so they could watch the fights. Police had to close down two blocks from 1:36 am to 2:37 am to clear traffic. Once order was restored, numerous citations were issued for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest. A total of NINE squads were needed along with Engine 32 and Med 7 from the Milwaukee Fire Department and Curtis Ambulance. These incidents were also caught on video tape for future reference.
47. On 04/01/08 at 11:20 pm, Milwaukee police were flagged down by Louis W Hicks who works security for Questions Night Club at 3041 W North Avenue. Hicks stated at 10:20 pm, he observed three subjects near an auto, which was found to be damaged. When Hicks approached them, they all ran but Hicks was able to catch one actor. This subject had no ID on him and when Hicks could not confirm his identity, let him go. A report was filed regarding the damage to the auto and while officers were there, observed numerous cars that were illegally parked around the tavern. A total of 20 parking tickets were issued.

48. On 04/02/08 at 1:49 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 24<sup>th</sup> Place and Brown Street for a Suspicious Person complaint. Investigation revealed this subject had been a patron at Questions and left the tavern when police stopped him at 24<sup>th</sup> Pl and Brown. The suspect was found to be in possession of a handgun along with the drug Ecstasy. The suspect stated he bought the Ecstasy while inside the Questions tavern and implicated that he was also armed while inside the tavern. The suspect was charged with Felon In Possession, Carrying Concealed Weapon, Resisting An Officer and POCS W/Intent.
49. On 04/05/08 at 1:10 am, Milwaukee police observed a disorderly patron outside of Questions Nightclub along with security. Police spoke to security officer Joshua Fritz who stated the subject was yelling obscenities inside the tavern and was escorted out. As the subject was leaving he pulled a large bottle out of his pocket and attempted to hit Fritz with it. The patron was still disorderly when police approached and a citation for Disorderly Conduct was issued.
50. On 04/07/08 at 1:43 am, several squads responded to area of 3041 W North Avenue due to complaints of large crowds and traffic congestion. Five squads were need to restore order.
51. On 04/14/08 at 1:42 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Fight complaint. Investigation revealed a male patron was beating up a female patron outside of the tavern when security tried to break it up. The male then started to fight with security with the security officers using their OC to gain control of the suspect. Security officers placed the suspect in handcuffs and called police. An ambulance was called to flush out the suspects eyes and he was arrested and charged with Battery.
52. On 04/21/08 at 12:37 am, several squads were need for a Fight complaint at 3041 W North Avenue. Investigation revealed several females fighting inside Questions. These patrons were heavily intoxicated and yelling obscenities at police. Citations were issued for Disorderly Conduct but had to be re-issued due to incorrect ordinance numbers. Police attempted to talk with Devon Reid but he was argumentive upon learning the citations were being re-issued.
53. On 04/28/08 at 1:40 am, Milwaukee police were in the area of Questions Night Club as the tavern was closing and observed large number of patrons who were loitering in the area circling the tavern in their autos. Four squads were needed to clear the area.
54. On 05/12/08 at 12:17 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Battery complaint and wide spread fights. Officers investigated a Substantial Battery complaint while other officers' controlled crowd and traffic problems. One patron was arrested on warrants. A total of SEVEN squad cars were needed along with MFD Engine 32 and MFD Ladder 9.
55. On 05/14/08 at 1:00 am, Milwaukee police were flagged down by security for Questions regarding a subject possible wanted by police. Security located the patron and police escorted him out of the tavern for further investigation. The subject was found to have used a fake ID to gain entry into the nightclub and was underage. The subject was not wanted however he received citations for Presence of Underage and Minor/Underage Misrepresent Age.

56. On 06/02/08 at 1:17 am, additional squads were requested at Questions Night Club for a Fight complaint. Several females were fighting each other and police. Large crowds were gathering from autos and watching the fights causing traffic congestion. Many were using profanities and trying to get others to fight from the crowd. Several citations were issued along with eleven parking citations.
57. On 06/23/08 at 2:04 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 31<sup>st</sup> / Garfield for Shots Fired complaint. Investigation revealed a property damage accident occurred. While investigating the accident, police heard shots fired in the area of Questions Night Club. No crime scene was found and the accident investigation found that all parties were patrons of Questions and had been drinking.
58. On 07/02/08 at 12:58 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Fight inside Questions Night Club. As police arrived, they observed security escorting several subjects out of club who had started a fight. Security stated all parties involved were escorted out but over heard comments that some were going to get their guns. Police observed several cars circling around the block and called for additional cars since the bar was starting to close and large crowds were in the area. A total of ten squads were needed for crowd and traffic control.
59. On 07/04/08 at 1:50 am, Milwaukee police were monitoring Questions Night Club and observed an intoxicated patron who left the club walking in the street causing traffic to stop. Security from the club yelled for the patron to get out of the road with the patron answering back with obscenities. Officers issued the subject a citation for Disorderly Conduct.
60. On 07/10/08 at 10:29 pm, Milwaukee police were flagged down by the owner of Questions regarding a Trouble With Subject. Devon Reid stated a female subject that was on scene earlier attempted to enter the tavern with a fake ID card. When security confiscated the ID card, the female began to cause a disturbance. The area was checked for the subject but police were unsuccessful in locating the woman.
61. On 07/14/08 at 11:20 pm, Milwaukee police were monitoring the area around Questions Night Club and found numerous illegally parked autos. Sixteen citations were issued with one car being towed. Later at 12:10 am, officers observed a security guard identified as Louis Hicks and a patron begin to fight. Both received Disorderly Conduct tickets. One patron was arrested for outstanding warrants.

62. On 08/01/08 at 3:40 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to St Joseph's Hospital for a Battery/Cutting complaint. Officers spoke to the victim who stated he was at Questions earlier that night and starting talking to female. A known female began yelling at him because he was talking to another girl. The argument continued until the bar closed when the known female pulled a kitchen knife from her purse and cut the victim on his shoulder. The victim sustained a one-inch laceration that required 3 stitches to close.
63. On 08/08/08 at 12:04 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Trouble With Subject complaint. The caller alleged that a female security guard from Questions had stolen a pound a marijuana from a customer. Police were only able to make contact with the caller by phone who became uncooperative. Security for Questions stated that no marijuana was confiscated, but that earlier they ejected several females from the tavern and the call was probably in retaliation.
64. On 08/20/08, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 31<sup>st</sup>/ North Avenue for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police spoke to two victims who stated they left Questions around 1:30 am and were followed by two men who also left the club and were asking for the womens phone numbers. When one victim refused, one of the males pulled out a gun and demanded the two womens money. After the robbery, the women reported that they heard nine gunshots fired in the area. Both victims stated they were unsure if the suspects fired the shots. A report was filed regarding the robberies.
65. On 09/10/08, due to numerous incidents requiring police response, Milwaukee police were in the area of 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue near closing time of the Questions Night Club. At approximately 1:36 am, officers heard two gun shots fired in the area. Security from Questions pointed out the vehicle involved in shots fired and officers stopped the auto approximately four blocks away. Officers arrested the four occupants and located a gun inside the vehicle. Officers interviewed the driver of the auto, who stated he and some friends had been at the Questions Club when the club began closing. He stated he and his friends left the tavern and got into his auto when he heard shots being fired and observed a group of people standing mid block on W North Avenue between 31<sup>st</sup> and 32<sup>nd</sup> Streets. He then started to drive his auto when he observed his passenger in the front seat standing on the floorboard, hanging out the window shooting off a gun. Video surveillance obtained from a business across the street showed a group of patrons walking on the south side of W North Avenue between 31<sup>st</sup> and 32<sup>nd</sup> Streets as a male in the group raised his hand firing shots from a handgun. Officers recovered three different types of casings in front of 3117-19 W North Avenue. Police spoke to the residents of 3117-19 W North Avenue and the investigation revealed that two windows to the victims home were shot out by gunfire, one being where the victim had been sleeping. The victim stated she feared she would get shot and stayed low to the ground and yelled to her husband to call police. The victim relayed to police that she, her husband and their son live in the residence and that they feared for their safety. The DA's office reviewed the case and determined they could not prove who was in possession of the firearm at the time shots were fired and decided not to charge the suspects who were arrested in regards to this incident.

66. On 09/17/08 at 1:47 am, Milwaukee police were monitoring Questions Night Club when they observed a Chevy pick up truck traveling E/B on W North Avenue with two males occupants. The front seat passenger of said auto fired five gunshots then fled the scene. There were approximately 100 patrons in the vicinity of the club at the time of this incident. Police stopped the auto in the 2600 block of N 27<sup>th</sup> Street and arrested both suspects who admitted to police that they were patrons at Questions Tavern prior to the shots being fired. The gun and casings were recovered from the auto.
67. On 10/09/08 at 1:10 am, Milwaukee police were on routine patrol when officers observed two subjects ducking down by parked autos in the lot of Questions Night Club. Officers then observed money on the ground as the two subjects began to roll dice. Officers conducted field interviews and when questioned, both stated they were just gambling and it was nothing big. They both also stated they work for the club as security. These subjects were identified as Antwan Hogans and Charlie Davis. Hogans stated to officers that they both get paid \$20.00 an hour to watch cars so they do not get broken into. Officers spoke to the licensee Devon Reid who stated he did not know either man. Reid was informed a report would be filed and stated to police that he cannot be held responsible for what goes on outside of the club. Police also issued 16 parking tickets due to illegally parked autos in the immediate vicinity of Questions Night Club.
68. On 10/31/08 at 11:53 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to Questions for a Battery complaint. Police were advised that a subject was struck in the face while attempting to enter the tavern. Upon arrival, police were unable to locate the victim. Curtis ambulance was on scene and was also unable to locate the victim.
69. On 11/05/08 at 1:15 am, Milwaukee police were monitoring Questions tavern for crowd and traffic control. Officers observed a security guard from the tavern walking on North Avenue attempting to direct traffic and user the crowd away. Officers also observed this guard armed with a pistol grip shotgun that was slung across his chest. Officers called for more squads and a supervisor to respond to the location. Investigation found that the guard was licensed to possess the shotgun while on duty but he was also advised that he could not leave the property while armed. The guard then stated, " Well, with so many people getting robbed around here and the gun shots always going off at closing, I felt it was necessary." Due to the large crowds leaving the tavern, additional squads were needed to help control traffic and crowd control. At 1:28 am, a gunshot was heard coming from the crowd of patrons that had gathered on W. Garfield Avenue. A total of 9 squads and one supervisor were needed to help restore order.
70. On 11/13/08 at 6:31 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Burglar Alarm complaint. Investigation revealed that an entry did occur to the Questions Night Club. Damage was observed to two doors that were at the main entrance. Missing were bottles of liquor. The licensee, Devon Reid, was on scene prior to officers arrival. Officers asked to view video surveillance tape but were unable to. Reid stated he would attempt to retrieve and make a copy of the video and would contact police when he had a copy made. Reid also stated there was one prior burglary to the business several days ago but that he did not report it to the police. A report was filed.

71. On 11/27/08 at 11:00 pm, Milwaukee police were monitoring Questions Tavern for Crowd and Traffic Control problems. Police observed numerous parking violations in the area and determined to be caused by patrons patronizing Questions Tavern. Numerous autos were parked in bus loading zones, too close to fire hydrants, parking on a bridge overpasses and autos parked on private property. A total of 38 citations were written.
72. On 12/10/08 at 12:00 am, Milwaukee police were on the 2200 block of N 31<sup>st</sup> Street issuing parking tickets. Officers observed an auto stop in the middle of the street blocking traffic just south of North Avenue. As officers approached the auto, the driver activated the red flashing Led lights on the auto. Officers spoke to the driver, identified as Pamela Bergevain, who stated she was hired by Questions to handle security outside and that her boss ordered her to block traffic to alleviate traffic congestion caused by the road being narrowed by the snow banks. Bergevain further stated she only uses the lights when she is on the property. A citation was issued to Bergevain for Operate Vehicle With Flashing Lights. 15 parking citations were issued in the area of Questions Club.
73. On 01/01/09 at 2:32 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue for a Reckless Use of Weapon complaint. Investigation revealed a patron was denied entry to the club due to intoxication and that the club was at capacity. The patron became angry and tried to push pass security to get into the club. Security refused to let the patron in and she started to punch and kick security with security using pepper spray on the female subject. The female was then escorted to the corner of 31<sup>st</sup> and North Avenue. Security stated they attempted to help flush the females' eyes out but she refused and continued to fight with security. An ambulance was on scene where she refused medical attention. The female was arrested on outstanding warrants and was issued a citation for Assault & Battery.
74. 01/14/09 at 12:22 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3041 W North Avenue for a Battery complaint. Police spoke to the victim who stated she and a known actor had a confrontation inside the tavern at which time the known subject slapped her. The suspect was no longer on scene when officers arrived. Police spoke with security who stated both subjects frequent the tavern and have been known to engage in conflict. A citation was later issued to suspect for Battery.

\*\*\* On 10/03/06 and 04/17/07, applicant was found guilty on two municipal ordinance violations of Posting Of Occupancy Capacity Required. He was fined \$3,515.00 for the first violation and \$10,000.00 for the second. The first conviction, applicant owes \$3,480.00, which was due on 07/30/07 and has not been paid. It has been referred to collections. The second conviction the applicant owes \$1,500.00, which is due by 04/17/09.
