The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/18/2007, the applicant was charged in Milwaukee County for:

2. On 03/21/2009 at 1:29am Milwaukee Police responded to a battery complaint at 4014/4024 South Howell Avenue (Jersey's Sports Pub & Grill). Investigation revealed a patron at the bar was struck once in the face causing pain.
3. On 06/17/2009 at 11:11pm Milwaukee Police responded to a Noise Nuisance complaint at 4024 South Howell Avenue (Jersey's Sports Pub & Grill). Investigation revealed there were several patrons on the patio. These patrons were laughing and talking. Police advised the bartender; Scott Rick that there were still patrons outside on the patio and they were making enough noise that someone had called police. Rick stated the patio was usually closed by 10:30pm and that no one should be outside. Rick then went out to the patio and asked the remaining patrons to leave. The patrons complied.

4. On 07/17/2009 at 1:07am Milwaukee Police responded to a battery complaint at 4024 South Howell Avenue (Jersey's Sports Pub & Grill). Investigation revealed the applicant and her live-in boyfriend, Rodney J. Lass, were involved in a fight in the basement of the business. Lass punched and kicked the applicant causing pain and injury. A battery-domestic violence report was subsequently filed (police incident #091980015). The case was not processed by the Milwaukee District Attorney's office on 08/06/2009.
