

**The Milwaukee Foreclosure Prevention Event** will take place on Thursday, August 6 at the Bruce Guadalupe School, which is run by the United Community Center (UCC).

This FREE event will start at 2 PM, and go until 8 PM on August 6.

The school is located at 920 S. Ninth Street, it is on Ninth Street, two blocks south of National Avenue.\*

Representatives from a number of mortgage lenders will be at the event, eager for face-to-face meetings with their borrowers worried about foreclosure. Nonprofit housing counselors will also be there to meet with borrowers and to let them know what to expect when they talk to their lender.

While borrowers do **not** need to pre-register for the event, and they can just show up at any time between 2 and 8 PM, there are **two** things to keep in mind:

**First**, borrowers will be helped on a first come, first served basis, - so the earlier you arrive, the earlier you can get to see a counselor and/or meet with your lender.

**Second**, it will be helpful if, at a minimum, you bring a couple of your most recent pay stubs and your most recent statement from your lender. Make sure that you have your loan number with you.
