Who needs a Temporary Bartender's License?

The Temporary Bartender's License authorizes service of alcoholic beverages at licensed events held by religious, scientific, educational, benevolent or other corporations, or non-profit organizations only.

If you currently have a City of Milwaukee Class "D" Bartender's license, this license is not required.

LICENSE PERIOD

The date or dates of the specific event, not to exceed fourteen (14) consecutive days.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be 18 years old at the time of filing.
- The event at which the applicant will be working **must hold an alcohol beverage license before** a temporary bartender's license application can be submitted.
- **Applicant must be an employee of or donating his/her services to a non-profit organization.**
- No person may hold more than one temporary bartender's license per year.
