### RESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PARKING PERMIT (RPP) Milwaukee Code of Ordinances 101-27.7(11)

Within part of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee commuter impacted area described in 101-27.7 (9)(c-18), resident-only parking zones are created whereby only vehicles bearing valid RPP permits issued pursuant to this subsection may be **parked on the block of the permit holder's residence and on the side of the street that is posted "No Parking Except RPP Permit"**. While a vehicle for which a RPP permit has been issued is so parked, the permit shall be displayed so as to be clearly visible through the lower left corner (driver's side) of the vehicle's windshield. A RPP permit shall not guarantee or reserve a parking space in the RPP-only parking zone. Further, all other parking regulations in the RPP zone, posted and un-posted, must be followed.

The RPP permit is valid **ONLY** on the block of the permit holder's residence as indicated on the face of the permit. A maximum of two RPP permits may be issued to one household for one or two vehicle owners if they are both residents of the same address. The Wisconsin State Driver's License used to apply for this permit must indicate the same address as the permit holder's residence in the RPP zone.

If the permit information is not readable, the permit holder must submit the actual permit to Milwaukee Police District #5 for re-issuance. Failure to do so may result in parking citations being issued. No manual changes to the permit may be made by the permit holder.

### TRANSFERABILITY

Only the registered motor vehicle(s) named on the residential preference permit shall be eligible to display the permit. Any transference of this permit to vehicles other than those named shall constitute a violation of this regulation. It shall constitute a violation of this regulation for any person to falsely represent himself/herself as eligible for a RPP permit.
