

**MINIMUM SPECIFICATION FOR
9,200 POUND GVW FOUR WHEEL DRIVE, FULL SIZE,
EXTENDED CAB PICK-UP TRUCK
(Highway)**

1. SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

1.1 It is the intent of this specification to describe the requirements for the purchase of one (1) 9,200 POUND GVW FOUR WHEEL DRIVE, FULL SIZE, EXTENDED CAB PICK-UP TRUCK.

2. DOCUMENTS

2.1 Each vendor shall provide two (2) complete bid packages including informational/promotional literature that describes the equipment to be installed.

3. REQUIREMENTS

THE COMPLIANCE SPACE MUST BE COMPLETED THOROUGHLY AND ACCURATELY. IF A VENDOR CHECKS “NO” TO MEETING ANY OF THE SPECIFICATIONS, THEY MUST INCLUDE A WRITTEN EXPLANATION AND ATTACH IT TO THE BID.

3.1 FULL SIZE PICK-UP TRUCK

3.1a CHASSIS

- 1. Payload of 3,500 pounds.**
- 2. Wheelbase of 157 inches**
- 3. Chrome front bumper.**
- 4. Step type rear bumper.**
- 5. Pick-up box with inside length of 96” and inside width of 50” between the wheel wells. Sides and tailgate to be double walled construction.**
- 6. Off-road skid plate that protects the front differential, transfer case and oil pan.**

1. 6.0L (363), 300 hp, SFI V8 Vortec, gasoline, LEV CERTIFIED.
2. Heavy duty cooling system with overflow reservoir.
3. 145 AMP alternator.

1. Four wheel drive
2. Heavy duty four speed automatic transmission with overdrive.

2. Heavy duty shock absorbers front and rear.

1. Power steering.

3.1f WHEELS/TIRES

1. **LT245/75R16E, blackwall, Goodyear Wrangler AT or equal tread design.**
2. **Sixteen inch (16") painted steel wheels.**
3. **One (1) full size mounted spare tire and wheel.**

3.1g BRAKES

1. **ABS power disc brakes on all four wheels.**

3.1h CAB

1. **The cab shall be extended all welded construction.**
2. **The seats shall be heavy duty vinyl covered bench and have seat belts for the driver and all passengers.**
3. **The instrumentation shall include speedometer, tachometer, odometer, trip odometer, voltmeter, fuel level, engine temperature and oil pressure.**
4. **The vehicle shall be equipped with an AM/FM radio, windshield wipers with intermittent control, tilt steering wheel, dual electric horns, dual mirrors and air conditioning.**
5. **The floor of the cab shall be covered by heavy duty black rubber floor covering.**

3.1i COLOR

1. **The vehicle shall be painted DuPont Ward LaFrance yellow, #7744.**
2. **The interior color of the vehicle shall be charcoal gray.**

3.1j ACCESSORIES

1. Two, front mounted tow hooks.
2. Heavy duty trailering package which includes weight distribution hitch platform, trailering wire harness which incorporates a Velvac 6-pin part #055052 female receptacle mounted on the rear of the vehicle, engine oil cooler, high capacity air cleaner and an installed factory receiver hitch rated at truck maximum capacity with forged pintle hitch and ball combination, Drawtight Model BH82000, 2" ball, 16,000GTW/3,000TW
3. Freeze plug type engine block heater.
4. Electric trailer brakes with cab mounted controller, Activator II, part #5500.
5. An amber North American DFS625-A strobe light installed on a cab mounted light bar and controlled by a lighted switch in the cab.
6. A self-adjusting Smart Alarm, ECCO Model #SA901 back-up alarm.
7. A white textured aluminum bed cap with rear opening window and four (4) side windows; two (2) approximately 20" by 16" and two (2) approximately 56" by 16". The two (2) windows that are 56" by 16" shall open from either side.

3.1k BED LINER

1. The entire inside of the cargo bed, including the inside of the tail gate, shall be treated with Rhino Coat or Line-X. No Substitutes.
2. The coating shall extend up the inside of the bed and tailgate, cover the top edges of the bed and tailgate and extend 2" down the external vertical surface of the bed and tailgate.

3.1l RUSTPROOFING.

1. The vehicle shall be protected against rust by Ziebart or Tuff-Kote Dinol with a dry film thickness of 10 – 15 mil.

4. GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

4.1 NEW EQUIPMENT

4.1a The equipment shall be the current, new and unused model built by the manufacturer. The equipment must be delivered completely assembled and ready for operation at the time of delivery.

4.2 PARTS AND SERVICE

4.2a The vendor must have an authorized parts and service facility located within 110 miles of Milwaukee County with a sufficient stock of parts and trained technicians to service the equipment.

4.3 MANUALS

4.3a The successful vendor shall upon delivery, furnish one complete set of parts and service manuals which cover the equipment specified. Five hundred (\$500) dollars of the final payment will be withheld until all of the above is received.

4.4 TRAINING

4.4a The successful vendor, at a time mutually acceptable with Milwaukee County, shall provide four (4) hours of training to operators and service technicians covering the operation and maintenance of the equipment, if requested.

4.5 WARRANTY

4.5a The warranty shall start the first day the vehicle is placed in service. The manufacturer shall warrant the entire vehicle, furnished equipment and devices against parts failure or malfunction due to design, construction, installation or errors in assembly of components, defective materials and workmanship. The vendor shall include with the bid document a warranty statement outlining the base warranty covering the vehicle/equipment bid.

4.5b Should any vehicle in this bid encounter a defect while under warranty, the vendor will be responsible for all costs associated with transporting the vehicle to and from an authorized service facility. The vendor will be required to respond to all warranty requests for service, including picking-up of the vehicle, within 24 hours of being contacted by Milwaukee County Fleet Management. All repairs covered under warranty are to be completed on a timely basis.

4.6 ALTERNATIVES AND APPROVED EQUAL

4.6a If an approved equal is requested, the bidder shall request consideration for approved equal status by submitting the appropriate documentation demonstrating equal status a minimum of ten (10) working days prior to the time scheduled for bid opening. Milwaukee County reserves the right to not consider requests that are submitted without documentation and/ or less than ten (10) working days prior to the time scheduled for bid opening.

4.7 DEMONSTRATION

4.7a Milwaukee County reserves the right to request a demonstration of any bidder's proposed equipment prior to issuance of a purchase order.

4.8 PRICE AND DELIVERY

4.8a The price bid for the equipment must be NET PRICE DELIVERED. Any bid modifying or "escalator" clauses will not be considered.

4.8b The vendor shall state the length of time required for delivery to Milwaukee County. Delivery to Milwaukee County must occur within 20 - 30 days after the vendor receives the vehicle from the supplier.
