**WALKER HOSTS “GOLDEN IDOL” COMPETITION
FOR MILWAUKEE COUNTY SENIORS**



MILWAUKEE – County Executive Scott Walker will host Milwaukee County’s “Golden Idol” competition together with the Department on Aging tomorrow at the Washington Park Senior Center. Thirty entrants auditioned to make the final cut of 10 acts to compete for the Golden Idol title.

John McGivern will emcee the competition and local celebrity judges will select a “Golden Idol” winner and three runners-up. Acts that made the finals include a chorus, vocalists, banjo, synthesizer keyboard, guitar, tap dancer, show dancer and line dancers.

Time Warner Cable, the major sponsor, will tape the program with Wisconsin on Demand digital cable Channel 1111 to air this month for a Viewer’s Choice winner. The winning talent will perform at State Fair and make goodwill ambassador appearances at Department on Aging events throughout the year.

The program will also feature entertainment by the Milwaukee Bucks Senioree Dance Team, keyboardist and singer David Skinner, and Razzmatazz, a jazz combo made up of senior members.
