The 9th Street tunnel entrance to the Courthouse, the MacArthur Square entrance to the Safety Building, and the Vel Phillips Juvenile Justice Center will be open only for jurors to report for jury duty and for necessary court-related access at 8:00 a.m. and close at 5:00 p.m. These entrances will be open to the non-court general public from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday hours:

Criminal Justice Facility – open at 8:30 a.m. for those arriving for Intake Court and closed to the general public at 3:30 p.m.

Vel Phillips Juvenile Justice Center – general public visitation hours:
