Senator Coggs named "Senator of the Year"

State Sen. Spencer Coggs has been named "Senator of the Year" by the Wisconsin Alliance of cities for his work in supporting and authoring legislation that protects taxpayers and fosters of growth, healthy development and quality of life of urban areas in Wisconsin. The Alliance, a non-profit group that advocates for cities, represents 38 communities in Wisconsin Legislature. Sen. Coggs was rated highest in Senate.

"This man is about policy, not politics," said Ed Huck, Executive Director of the Alliance of Cities. "Sen. Coggs has demonstrated that approach consistently over the 26 years he's been in the Legislature."

During the event at Milwaukee's City Hall, Sen. Coggs was also presented with citations in recognition of his work from the Milwaukee Common Council and the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors. "Year in and year out, young and old, rich and poor, look to the cities that address education, lead poisoning, gun violence, the safety of children in day care, and property tax relief.

He also authored Total Prescription, or T-Rx, a

program that helps reduce the cost of prescription drugs for citizens by using the state's buying power. The program evolved into Gov. Doyle's Badger Rx and was passed into law. Most recently, Sen. Coggs authored the Pension Plan Revision Bill that will assist Milwaukee County in solving its multi-million dollar employee pension obligation. Sen. Coggs is a former City of Milwaukee health officer, a former chief steward of AFSCME Local 1091, and is currently chair of the Senate Committee on Labor, Elections and Urban Affairs.
