The tenth district welcomed the grand opening of the new United House Apartments at 25th and Center in Milwaukee on August 28th. United House is the first housing project aimed at helping individuals with mental illness. The project was made possible in part by grants from Milwaukee County, the City of Milwaukee, and the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA).

I'm pleased the County Board helped move this project forward. We will continue to make quality mental health services a priority as we craft the 2009 County Budget.

This collaborative effort would not have been possible without the support of Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., and Toni M. Clark, along with Milwaukee Alderman Willie Wade, Pastor Elloyd Jones and Spencer Wynn of United Christian Church, and Capital Cardinal Management.

The 24-unit development provides one-bedroom housing units for individuals with mental illness. Applicants for the property must be approved through the Independent Living Program at Milwaukee County's Behavioral Health Division.
