I hope you had a fun filled, eventful, and safe summer. As your newly elected Milwaukee County Supervisor, I would like to take a few minutes to introduce myself. Born, raised, and educated in Milwaukee, I am a graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee with a Master's Degree in Adult Education and a Bachelor's Degree in Community Education. I also completed a certificate in Nonprofit Management from the Helen Bader Institute. I raised three younger siblings after the loss of our mother over 8 years ago in Milwaukee County.

I have spent the majority of my career working with youth as a nurturer, mentor, and educator. In my most recent position, I worked at the Urban Ecology Center where I coordinated, planned, and organized fundraising events including scholarship fundraisers, developed and facilitated cultural competency workshops for youth and adults, and assisted with membership.

I was sworn-in on June 3, 2010, which marks the first day I was on the job representing you and our community as the County Supervisor of the 2nd District. I am honored and deeply thank you for electing me to represent our community. I have spent over 60 days meeting with department heads, touring County facilities and meeting with neighbors throughout the 2nd District to address issues that directly impact our community.

Over the next couple months, the Milwaukee County Board will work on the 2011 County Budget. The Town Hall meetings mentioned in the 2nd District Community Events section are opportunities for you to share with me our community needs and how you would like to see the Board prioritize our spending for Milwaukee County as a whole. I will take key stances on sustaining th Milwaukee County Transit System by securing a dedicated funding source. I am aso looking into resources that will help keep our parks safe, clean and well maintained. However, these are issues I cannot fight alone. I need to hear from you because your opinion counts.

Finally, my office has put in place the procedure of receiving and attending to constituent Calls for Service. I have already received hundreds of calls. I pledge to respond to all constituents. With the assistance of Jermaine Murry, my Legislative Assistant, we will review all calls and communicate with you in an appropriate manner.

If you have any concerns, please call my office. I know the current budget process will be difficult. I have heard from constituents about bus route cuts, park preservation, the need to hold the line on taxes and others. As I embrace this difficult budget year. I will do my best to be an effective Supervisor while balancing all of your concerns. THANK YOU!

Havenwoods Economic Development Corporation

Havenwoods Economic Development Corporation (HEDC) is a non-profit group working to revitalize and improve the City's far northwest side, also known as the Havenwoods Community. This neighborhood stretches from N. 43rd St. to N. 76th and Silver Spring Drive to Good Hope Road.

Since being formed by local businesses in 2002, HEDC has adopted a variety of initiatives to improve public spaces. So far, activities have included CDBG funded community organizing & crime prevention, capital improvements to public infrastructure, business assistance, Façade Grants, Graffiti Abatement Grants and neighborhood planning.

The most recent initiative, funded by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation, is the Healthy Neighborhoods Initiative. There are currently nine Milwaukee healthy neighborhoods working to stabilize local real estate, encourage investment, connect neighbors to resources and to one another, and improve the overall image of their areas.

HEDC also works synergistically with the Business Improvement District #31 to deliver additional resources and services to business and residents to make Havenwoods the neighborhood of choice for businesses and residents.
