NATURALIZATION CEREMONY TO BE HELD IN CUDAHY JULY 10TH

Milwaukee, WI – The Cudahy Historical Society, in partnership with community leaders, is proudly hosting a Naturalization Ceremony on July 10th and inviting members of the community to attend:

Milwaukee County Supervisor Patricia Jursik will serve as Master of Ceremonies. A federal judge will administer the Oath of Citizenship, facilitated by the Immigration and Naturalization Service. Proceedings will include the National Anthem, a color guard, and remarks by Cudahy Mayor Ryan McCue and Historical Society President Cherri Nadolny.

Naturalization proceedings normally occur within the Federal Building, but Congresswoman Gwen Moore worked to make this experience in Cudahy possible.

The program provides a chance for residents of Cudahy, the 8th Supervisory District, and Milwaukee County to reflect on the responsibilities of citizenship as well as the importance of immigration, past and present, in our community.
