

# **RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGIST MAMMOGRAPHER**

**THE PURPOSE:** The Radiologic Technologist performs mammograms and clinical breast exams, maintains related equipment, and prepares quality control procedures according to the American College of Radiology (ACR) specifications.

## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Perform mammograms, develop film and complete appropriate documentation in accordance with ACR specifications.
- Perform clinical breast examinations and instruct patients on the procedures and frequency of breast self-examinations as well as the proper and complete documentation of examinations.
- Perform general record keeping duties related to client registration, screening, and follow-up.
- Transport and hang developed film for Radiologist interpretation; locations may vary.
- Perform quality control procedures for equipment in the mammography suite and darkroom.
- Maintain regulatory requirements for the facility, prepare and submit necessary documentation to ACR and MQSA.
- Order clinics supplies and maintain back up supply in MBCCAP office.
- Maintain cleanliness in examining room, mammography suite, and darkroom.
- Perform other related functions as assigned.

## **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Graduation from an American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) recognized educational program in Radiologic Technology.
2. Current ARRT registration as a Radiologic Technologist (R) and Mammographer (M). Registration must be maintained throughout employment.
3. Ability to meet and maintain MQSA (Mammography Quality Standards Act) formal training, continuing education, and continuing experience requirements.
4. Residency in the City of Milwaukee within six (6) months of appointment and throughout employment.

- Ability to work effectively and maintain good relationships with a multi-cultural, multi-disciplined staff and public.
- Ability to maintain sensitivity to client needs and concerns.
