CONTRACT 1: PVC POOL LINING SYSTEM

Work includes furnishing and installing a PVC pool renovation membrane for the Wilson Park Diving Pool, approximately 9,100 square feet of surface area. The pool lining system shall provide a waterproof lining of the existing pool over the poly felt complete with all necessary hardware, fittings, attachments, flanges, gaskets and all appropriate pool markings required by state pool codes. The PVC membrane shall be minimum 60-mil thick. Membrane shall be UV and Chemical Stabilized with Maximal UV and chlorine resistance with acrylic stain guard topcoat. All existing pool markings inside the liner zone shall be replaced with full markings in accordance with state code. Warranty shall be 15-years.

Project Completion: Work shall be Substantially Complete by May 30, 2008.

Pre-Bid Meeting: March 5, 2008 at 1:30 P.M., meet at the Wilson Park Diving Pool project site, 4001 South 20th Street, Milwaukee, WI.

SPECIAL BID SUBMITTALS SHALL BE INCLUDED WITH BID SUBMISSION. BIDDERS SHALL NOTE INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS CERTIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT PROVIDING THE SPECIFIED PVC POOL LINER. FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE SPECIAL BID SUBMITTAL WITH THE BID WILL BE CONSIDERED NON-RESPONSIVE AND RESULT IN RECOMMENDATION OF REJECTION OF BID.

ALLOW ADDITIONAL TIME TO BE PROCESSED THROUGH SECURITY SCREENING STATIONS AT COURTHOUSE ENTRANCES.

Sealed bids are due in the County Clerk's Office, Room 105, Milwaukee County Courthouse, on March 12, 2008 at 2 P.M.

Bids will be publicly read in Room 105, Milwaukee County Courthouse, 5 minutes after due time.
