

## ABOUT THE TEST

In order to get a city of Milwaukee license to drive a taxicab, you must first pass a test relating to knowledge of city streets, major buildings and facilities, knowledge of city public passenger vehicle regulations, and map use.

**You have 60 minutes to complete the 40-question test.**

A score of at least 28 correct answers is required in order to pass the test.



## PART



**Consists of 18 multiple-choice questions** that test your knowledge of city streets, major buildings and facilities. Provided below are example questions.

1. Which street is the Pfister Hotel located on?
2. Which street is the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts located on?
3. Which intersection is Aurora Sinai Hospital located at?
4. Which diagonal street goes to the Village of Hales Corners?
5. If you were traveling from General Mitchell International Airport on I-94 W, which freeway exit would you use for Rockwell Automation?
6. Which hundred block is Capitol Drive located at?
7. Which direction(s) is traffic permitted to travel on State Street between Van Buren Street and Water Street?
8. What is the address of the U.S. Bank Center?
9. Which hotel is located closest to General Mitchell International Airport?
10. What is the address of the Betty Brinn Children's Museum?
11. Which of the following hospitals is located closest to the Milwaukee Public Museum?
12. Which street is the Wyndham Milwaukee Center Hotel located on?
13. Which intersection is the Pabst Theater located at?

**Consists of 10 multiple-choice questions** that test your knowledge of city public passenger vehicle regulations established in chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. Provided below are example questions.

1. What actions may a public passenger vehicle driver's license be subject to if the license holder violates any rule or regulation relating to public passenger vehicles?
2. For whom is a driver of a public passenger vehicle permitted to decline service?
3. When are drivers of public passenger vehicles permitted to smoke in their vehicles?
4. How often is a driver of a public passenger vehicle required to inspect the vehicle to make sure that all equipment on the vehicle is operable and in good working condition?
5. How often must public passenger vehicles be washed?
6. What information must every driver write on daily trip records?
7. What items are required to be provided inside every public passenger vehicle?
8. If a red sticker is placed on a public passenger vehicle indicating that the vehicle is suspended from public service as being unsafe, who is permitted to remove the red sticker?
9. How many passengers in addition to the driver are permitted in the front seat of a public passenger vehicle?
10. How many hours in every 24 hours may a person driving a public passenger vehicle upon the public streets be required to work?
